Mission:

The OSLP Arts & Culture Program breaks down barriers to participation in the arts for people of all abilities and builds bridges to a more diverse and inclusive community.

About the program:

We provide workshops and mentorships with professional instructors in visual and performing arts as well as cultural activities in Eugene, Oregon. Our classes are inclusive for individuals of all abilities that are 18 years old and over.

Oregon Supported Living Program (OSLP)'s Arts & Culture Program began in 2012 in response to the limited and segregated artistic opportunities available to people with developmental and intellectual disabilities. The program serves OSLP clients, adults with disabilities from other support programs, and the general public. The Arts & Culture program is truly inclusive and open to individuals with and without disabilities, making it one of only a few programs of its kind in the US. We offer over ten different art classes taught by professional artists on a quarterly basis, including: Open art studio, fiber arts, photography, culinary arts, American sign language, chair-based yoga, mixed-abilities dance, mosaics, jewelry making, and music. In addition to our quarterly programming, we host one-time workshops by local artists, facilitate an artist mentorship program, and curate exhibitions in the community and at our on-site Lincoln Gallery.
